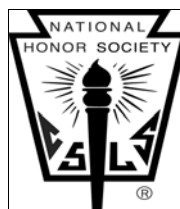
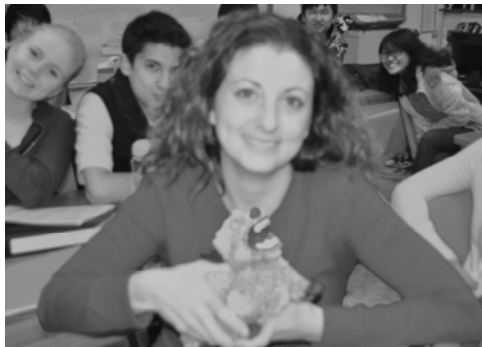

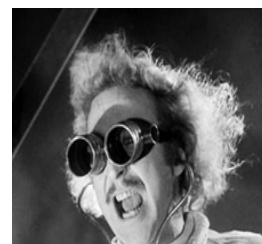

ERB is coming February 14th and 15th

What is ERB?

ERB stands for the *Educational Records Bureau*. ERB is a non-profit educational service organization that provides standardized testing and interpretation of results to schools. "ERB's" are standardized tests. Standardized tests use uniform procedures for administration and scoring in order to assure that the results from different people are comparable. Each student's essay is scored with respect to six different elements on a scale of one (low) to six (high).

The six elements are; overall development, organization, support, sentence structure, word choice, and mechanics. Day one will be approximately fifty minutes of prewriting to a prompt, and day two will be the preparation of a final draft.
