Graphing, graphing, and more graphing!

Graphing activities for preschool include collecting data and organizing it in a variety of ways. When children walk around the classroom and ask their friends which cereal they prefer, put a tally mark under the cereal picture, and count how many tally marks are in each column; they are not only graphing, but also working with statistics or data analysis.

The 4 year old boys and girls have been walking around school and doing surveys with the teachers, friends, guards and the cleaning ladies. They are having fun learning about picture graphs.
