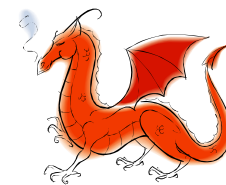

was a solid tie – everyone had fun and those who were nudged out took it with good grace. It was a

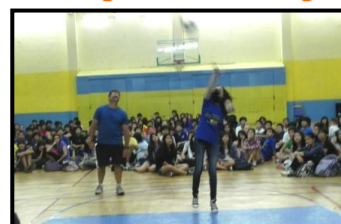
great year in sports and a great day to remember them.

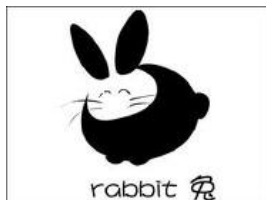


Come See The Wizard of Oz

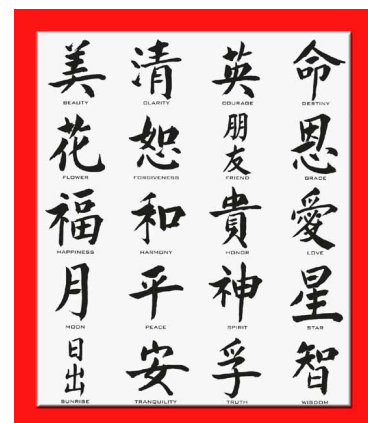
